Does your facility utilize MedScribe's physician electronic signature? If not, you should call us today! Your physicians can read, edit, print and sign documents from a secure web accessible program called WebPortal. Physicians are able to sign off on documents from any computer with internet access saving themselves and the HIM Department time.

The MedScribe ChartNet system provides the ability to run a variety of management reports, allowing you to monitor the entire transcription process.

Available reports include: turnaround time; billing; report distribution; e-signature; job status; and system usage. Simply click on "Reporting" from the ChartNet console to view the available reports.
